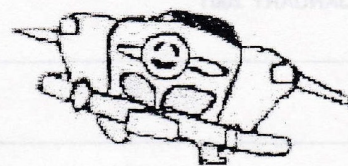

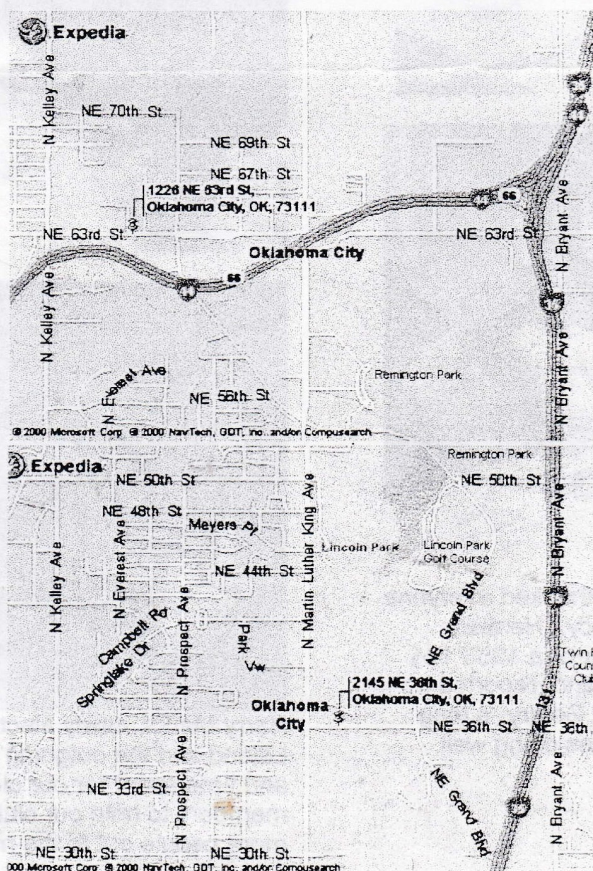

Our holiday meeting was held at the Hometown Buffet on Saturday, December 9<sup>th</sup>. At 6:00 PM.

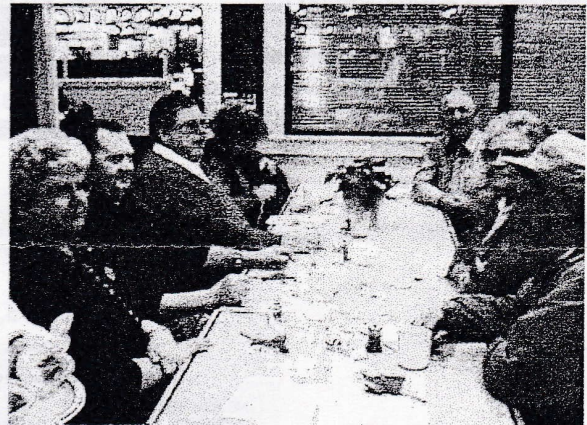
